- The walk is about 60 90 minutes long, wear comfortable shoes

- Please enter the building and let the Front of House staff know that you have arrived for Duppy Hunter
- A member of staff will welcome you and the group joining you on your adventure. They will give you more information and answer any questions you have
- You will do a sound check at Trinity and once all is OK and you can hear everything you need to, you will be on your way to where your adventure begins

Technical aspects to consider

- Once you start your adventure you can lock your screen, put your phone in your pocket and enjoy the experience. You will be prompted by a character and/or in moments of silence you will need to go back to your screen to either push a button, type in some text or even answer a question
- If you feel like you might be lost, you can also return to your screen and click the map icon, to get back on track
